

To help each of us to honor God and to get the most out of our online worship services, we've compiled a list of helpful tips. We hope these will help you to worship well these upcoming weeks.

- **When & Where?** Every Sunday at 10:00 AM we will live stream our Sunday worship on our [Triangle Grace Church Facebook Page](#).
- **Do I Need a Facebook Account?** No. The live stream is publicly available at the above URL even if you don't have an account.
- **Check Your Tech.** The night before, check your internet connection and your computer software and hardware (e.g., headphones, speakers, browser). Test out a video from our Facebook page. Problem solve any issues so that you have no problems the next day. Scrambling last minute with tech problems can be frustrating and can put your heart in not the best posture for worship. Also, be sure to have a printed copy of our resource document to follow during worship. You'll find that on the homepage of our website or in your Friday email.
- **Get There Early.** We will be starting promptly at 10:00 AM. Log in at least 5-10 minutes before so you can settle in and prepare yourself.
- **Set Aside this Time.** The biggest temptation with online worship is to treat it with less earnestness. Worship is first and foremost about honoring God, so let us set this time apart as we would our regular Sunday service. Instead of listening to the service in the background while eating breakfast or doing chores, set aside this time so that it is uninterrupted and so that you can be fully present for each element of worship.
- **Prepare Your Offering.** The giving of tithes and gifts is an important part of a believer's worship. It is also a concrete expression of worship, discipleship, trust, and gratitude. - **Engage.** After the service, take some time to reach out to other members in the church to see how they're doing, to share about what they experienced during service, and to pray for each other. Also, feel free to leave an encouraging comment on the live feed. Believe it or not, little expressions like that can impact and edify the community and help folks feel connected.
