Dear friends,

My wise professor of pastoral counseling, the late Dr. William Oglesby, used to say, "with every gain there is loss and with every loss there is gain." Perhaps more than ever, at this juncture in life those words resonate with me. As we peer into what promises to be our future (if the Lord wills), Diane and I see loss as well as gain. This past year and the pastoral overlap period have been helping me prepare for the loss and gain that the future holds. My hope is that it has been helpful for you as a church family as well. We will each experience some gain and loss in the process. I hope we can all see how both loss and gain can result in blessing. I truly believe they can.

Think about the mother and father experiencing the birth of their first child. There is in that event a sense of loss. There is a certain loss of freedom to come and go as they please. Spur of the moment getaways become major events that require thought and planning. There is a loss of the rhythms and patterns of life that have become familiar, not to mention the loss of sleep.

These losses are quite real. But they come as a direct result of tremendous gain. Every parent knows the great gain that manifests itself in the joy and wonder of holding a little one. Parents recognize the gain that is evident in the depth of their ability to love deeply when at first there is actually no discernable love in return. The gains that are experienced in parenthood would not be possible without the necessary losses that come as well.

There is a loss in sending our kids off to college but there is gain in seeing them flourish and become young adults with their own hopes and dreams.

I hope that in the transitions we are experiencing, necessary losses will blossom into beautiful opportunities for tremendous gain.

Perhaps you will experience some loss in what has been familiar for a long time. But you will gain fresh insights and fresh ideas and new voices to speak God's Word into your life that I know will reach into the deep places of your heart.

Even with the losses that Diane and I will experience being away from Triangle Grace, we are confident that God has some great gains in store for us as we are able to spend more time with our children and grandchildren and as we remain open to new avenues of ministry.

For a while I have been experiencing what I will call a variety of "lasts." As an example, just over a month ago I had a role in leading this congregation through the Advent and Christmas seasons for the "last" time. As Easter approaches it occurs to me that I was not even aware last year that it would be my "last" lent and Easter as the pastor of Triangle Grace. At the end of the year 2021, I led my "last" staff meeting. In December I also led the session meeting for the "last" time. Just recently I moderated the annual congregational meeting for the "last" time. These "lasts" may seem, at first glance, as places of loss, but I see them as stepping stones for the church that lead to great gain. The gain of new leadership for the church is a good thing and I encourage you to embrace it and support it. Kris and Molly have joined a great staff that you have known and loved for many years and already they are making wonderful contributions. I am looking forward to seeing how God continues to bless Triangle Grace Church and the new leadership team that is now in place with many "gains" in its future.

As I write my "last" newsletter article and as Diane and I take our leave, we would both say what an absolute privilege it has been for us to be your pastoral family for over 34 years. You have loved our family well. There are simply no words to express the depth of gratitude that we feel in our hearts for how you have cared for us and supported us through these years. God gave us a tremendous gift when He called us to serve this marvelous church. I pray that in some way we perhaps have touched your lives with God's grace as well.




