The trip begins in Delhi, with a visit to the Taj Mahal, the Red Fort, and the Spice and Textile Markets, and learning from ministry partners. We will fly first into Nagaland and spend four days, and then drive to Assam, spending four days. We will learn from, encourage, and be encouraged by pastors and leaders of seminaries and other ministries, while enjoying the hospitality and beauty of this special region and growing our understanding of the complex challenges facing the church there.

JULY 2026



Purpose: To provide an intergenerational mission trip experience in which those sent from Triangle Grace Church serve in collaboration with Guatemalan Christians to make Christ known in a greater capacity in Guatemala. This may include physical labor, working with children, leading worship, teaching and other opportunities as they may arise. Our team will work with Dayrin Cordona who has been attending our church this year. Dayrin is Guatemalan and will be on staff at SETECA (Seminario Teológico Centroamericano) in 2026. Her dad is a pastor who serves in the mountain region of Huehuetenango.

Dates: Mid-July 2026, 11 days

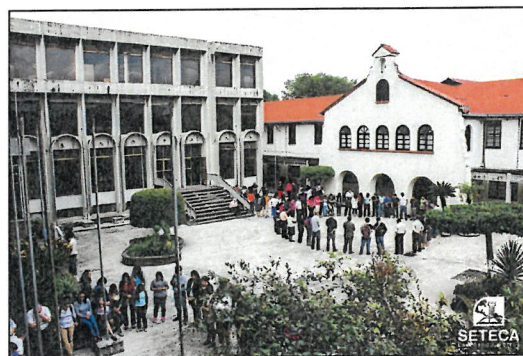
Location: Guatemala City, SETECA Seminary, Guatemala City, Guatemala and/or possibly the Huehuetenango region of Guatemala.
