### **What is SETECA?**

Most of our ten-day visit will be spent at the Theological Seminary of Central America (SETECA) working in conjunction with Dayrin Cordona. Dayrin worshipped with our church in 2024–25 and currently serves as a professor of theology on that campus. The seminary

### **What work will we be doing?**

Dayrin and the seminary leadership have invited us to partner with them in their ministry. Along with interacting with SETECA students, we plan to assist them with work projects on their campus to help them prepare for their 100th anniversary in 2028. We also intend to connect with students by providing faith-based presentations and opportunities to practice English. In addition, we will likely offer a vacation Bible school program at a local church and visit with several other Christian outreaches in the area.
